Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 252, Page 1, Section A, Line 3,

2 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 301.3031. 1. Whenever a vehicle owner pursuant to this  
 4 chapter makes an application for a military license plate, the  
 5 director of revenue shall notify the applicant that the applicant  
 6 may make a voluntary contribution of ten dollars to the World War  
 7 II memorial trust fund established pursuant to this section. The  
 8 director shall transfer all contributions collected to the state  
 9 treasurer for credit to and deposit in the trust fund. Beginning  
 10 August 28, 2013, the director of revenue shall no longer collect  
 11 the contribution authorized by this section.

12 2. There is established in the state treasury the "World  
 13 War II Memorial Trust Fund". The state treasurer shall credit to  
 14 and deposit in the World War II memorial trust fund all amounts  
 15 received pursuant to this section, and any other amounts which  
 16 may be received from grants, gifts, bequests, the federal  
 17 government, or other sources granted or given for purposes of  
 18 this section.

19 3. The Missouri veterans' commission shall administer the  
 20 trust fund. The trust fund shall be used to participate in the  
 21 funding of the National World War II Memorial to be located at a

1 site dedicated on November 11, 1995, on the National Mall in  
2 Washington, D.C.

3 4. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the trust  
4 fund in the same manner as surplus state funds are invested  
5 pursuant to section 30.260. All earnings resulting from the  
6 investment of moneys in the trust fund shall be credited to the  
7 trust fund. The general assembly may appropriate moneys annually  
8 from the trust fund to the department of revenue to offset costs  
9 incurred for collecting and transferring contributions pursuant  
10 to subsection 1 of this section. The provisions of section  
11 33.080 requiring all unexpended balances remaining in various  
12 state funds to be transferred and placed to the credit of the  
13 ordinary revenue fund of this state at the end of each biennium  
14 shall not apply to the trust fund.

15 301.3033. 1. Whenever a vehicle owner pursuant to this  
16 chapter makes an application for a military license plate, the  
17 director of revenue shall notify the applicant that the applicant  
18 may make a voluntary contribution of ten dollars to the World War  
19 I memorial trust fund established pursuant to this section. The  
20 director shall transfer all contributions collected to the state  
21 treasurer for credit to and deposit in the trust fund.

22 2. There is established in the state treasury the "World  
23 War I Memorial Trust Fund". The state treasurer shall credit to  
24 and deposit in the World War I memorial trust fund all amounts  
25 received pursuant subsection 1 of this section and any other  
26 amounts which may be received from grants, gifts, bequests, the  
27 federal government, or other sources granted or given for  
28 purposes of this section.

29 3. The Missouri veterans' commission shall administer the

1 trust fund established pursuant to this section. The trust fund  
2 shall be used for the sole purpose of the restoration,  
3 renovation, and maintenance of a memorial or museum or both  
4 dedicated to World War I in any home rule city with more than  
5 four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one  
6 county.

7 4. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the trust  
8 fund in the same manner as surplus state funds are invested  
9 pursuant to section 30.260. All earnings resulting from the  
10 investment of moneys in the trust fund shall be credited to the  
11 trust fund. The general assembly may appropriate moneys annually  
12 from the trust fund to the department of revenue to offset costs  
13 incurred for collecting and transferring contributions pursuant  
14 to subsection 1 of this section. The provisions of section  
15 33.080 requiring all unexpended balances remaining in various  
16 state funds to be transferred and placed to the credit of the  
17 ordinary revenue fund of this state at the end of each biennium  
18 shall not apply to the trust fund.
