Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 121, Page 1, Section title, Line 5

of said title, by inserting after "provisions" the following:

"and an emergency clause for a certain section"; and

Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 4 of said page, by inserting immediately after all of said line the following:

"311.055. 1. No person at least twenty-one years of age shall be required to obtain a license to manufacture intoxicating liquor, as defined in section 311.020, for personal or family use. The aggregate amount of intoxicating liquor manufactured per household shall not exceed two hundred gallons per calendar year if there are two or more persons over the age of twenty-one years in such household, or one hundred gallons per calendar year if there is only one person over the age of twenty-one years in such household. Any intoxicating liquor manufactured under this section may not be offered for sale.

2. Beer brewed under this section may be removed from the premises where brewed for personal or family use, including use at organized affairs, exhibitions, or competitions, such as home brewer contests, tastings, or judging. The use may occur off licensed retail premises, on any premises under a temporary

2 311.486, or 311.487, or on any tax exempt organization's licensed
3 premises as described in section 311.090."; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 8, section 316.150, line 21 of
5 said page, by inserting immediately after all of said line the
6 following:

7 "Section B. Because of the need to clarify the laws
8 relating to beer brewed for personal or family use, the repeal
9 and reenactment of section 311.055 of this act is deemed
10 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health,
11 welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an
12 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the
13 repeal and reenactment of section 311.055 of this act shall be in
14 full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

15 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
