"160.2110. 1. The task force on the prevention of sexual
abuse of children established in section 160.2100 may adopt and
implement a policy addressing sexual abuse of children that may
include:
(1) Age-appropriate curriculum for students in pre-K
through fifth grade;
(2) Training for school personnel on child sexual abuse;
(3) Educational information to parents or guardians
provided in the school handbook on the warning signs of a child
being abused, along with any needed assistance, referral, or
resource information;
(4) Available counseling and resources for students
affected by sexual abuse; and
(5) Emotional and educational support for a child of abuse
to continue to be successful in school.
2. Any policy adopted may address without limitation:
(1) Methods for increasing teacher, student, and parent
awareness of issues regarding sexual abuse of children, including

knowledge of likely warning signs indicating that a child may be

a victim of sexual abuse;

- (2) Actions that a child who is a victim of sexual abuse could take to obtain assistance and intervention; and
- (3) Available counseling options for students affected by sexual abuse.
- 2. Once the task force has adopted the policy as described under subsection 1 of this section, the department of elementary and secondary education shall implement the provisions of said policy including the promulgation of rules to accomplish such implementation." and
