Amend _____ SCS/Senate Bill No. 378, Page 5, Section 160.545, Line 139,

2 by inserting at the end of said line the following: "If an
 3 eligible student is unable to successfully complete at least
 4 twenty-four semester credit hours in a twelve-month period due to
 5 serious and unusual personal circumstances, such student may seek
 6 a waiver of this provision by appealing to the person or
 7 committee the institution the student attends has designated to
 8 consider appeals from students who are not in compliance with
 9 federal requirements regarding satisfactory academic progress.";

10 and

11 Further amend said bill, page 10, section 173.250, line 145,
 12 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

13 "10. If an eligible student is unable to successfully
 14 complete at least twenty-four semester credit hours in a twelve-
 15 month period due to serious and unusual personal circumstances,
 16 such student may seek a waiver of this provision by appealing to
 17 the person or committee the institution the student attends has
 18 designated to consider appeals from students who are not in
 19 compliance with federal requirements regarding satisfactory
 20 academic progress."; and

21 Further amend said bill, page 13, section 173.1104,
 22 line 96, by inserting immediately after said line the following:

1 "5. If an eligible student is unable to successfully
2 complete the number of hours required in subsection 3 of this
3 section due to serious and unusual personal circumstances, such
4 student may seek a waiver of this provision by appealing to the
5 person or committee the institution the student attends has
6 designated to consider appeals from students who are not in
7 compliance with federal requirements regarding satisfactory
8 academic progress."
