2 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 "115.607. 1. No person shall be elected or shall serve as  
4 a member of a county committee who is not, for one year next  
5 before the person's election, both a registered voter of and a  
6 resident of the county and the committee district from which the  
7 person is elected if such district shall have been so long  
8 established, and if not, then of the district or districts from  
9 which the same shall have been taken. Except as provided in  
10 subsections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of this section, the membership of  
11 a county committee of each established political party shall  
12 consist of a man and a woman elected from each township or ward  
13 in the county.

14 2. In each county of the first classification containing  
15 the major portion of a city which has over three hundred thousand  
16 inhabitants, [two members of the committee, a man and a woman,  
17 shall be elected from each ward in the city. Any township  
18 entirely contained in the city shall have no additional  
19 representation on the county committee. The election authority  
20 for the county shall, not later than six months after the  
21 decennial census has been reported to the President of the United  
22 States, divide the most populous township outside the city into

1 eight subdistricts of contiguous and compact territory and as  
2 nearly equal in population as practicable. The subdistricts  
3 shall be numbered from one upward consecutively, which numbers  
4 shall, insofar as practicable, be retained upon reapportionment.  
5 Two members of the county committee, a man and a woman, shall be  
6 elected from each such subdistrict. Six members of the  
7 committee, three men and three women, shall be elected from the  
8 second and third most populous townships outside the city. Four  
9 members of the committee, two men and two women, shall be elected  
10 from the other townships outside the city] members of the  
11 committee shall be elected from the districts of each state  
12 representative that are in any way contained in the county in the  
13 following manner: within six months after each legislative  
14 reapportionment, each portion of a legislative district contained  
15 in the county shall constitute a single committee district. Two  
16 men and two women shall be elected from each committee district  
17 formed from a legislative district that is wholly contained in  
18 the county as members of the committee, two men and two women  
19 shall be elected from each committee district formed from a  
20 legislative district that is predominantly contained in the  
21 county as members of the committee, and one man and one woman  
22 shall be elected from each committee district formed from a  
23 legislative district that is partially but not predominantly  
24 contained in the county as members of the committee.

25 3. [In any city which has over three hundred thousand  
26 inhabitants, the major portion of which is located in a county  
27 with a charter form of government, for the portion of the city  
28 located within such county and notwithstanding section 82.110, it  
29 shall be the duty of the election authority, not later than six

1 months after the decennial census has been reported to the  
2 President of the United States, to divide such cities into not  
3 less than twenty-four nor more than twenty-five wards after each  
4 decennial census. Wards shall be so divided that the number of  
5 inhabitants in any ward shall not exceed any other ward of the  
6 city and within the same county, by more than five percent,  
7 measured by the number of the inhabitants determined at the  
8 preceding decennial census.

9           4.] In each county of the first classification containing a  
10 portion, but not the major portion, of a city which has over  
11 three hundred thousand inhabitants, ten members of the committee,  
12 five men and five women, shall be elected from the district of  
13 each state representative wholly contained in the county in the  
14 following manner: within six months after each legislative  
15 reapportionment, the election authority shall divide each  
16 legislative district wholly contained in the county into five  
17 committee districts of contiguous territory as compact and as  
18 nearly equal in population as may be; two members of the  
19 committee, a man and a woman, shall be elected from each  
20 committee district. The election authority shall divide the area  
21 of the county located within legislative districts not wholly  
22 contained in the county into similar committee districts; two  
23 members of the committee, a man and a woman, shall be elected  
24 from each committee district.

25           [5.] 4. In each city not situated in a county, two members  
26 of the committee, a man and a woman, shall be elected from each  
27 ward.

28           [6.] 5. In all counties with a charter form of government  
29 and a population of over nine hundred thousand inhabitants, the

1 county committee persons shall be elected from each township.  
2 Within ninety days after August 28, 2002, and within six months  
3 after each decennial census has been reported to the President of  
4 the United States, the election authority shall divide the county  
5 into twenty-eight compact and contiguous townships containing  
6 populations as nearly equal in population to each other as is  
7 practical.

8 [7.] 6. If any election authority has failed to adopt a  
9 reapportionment plan by the deadline set forth in this section,  
10 the county commission, sitting as a reapportionment commission,  
11 shall within sixty days after the deadline, adopt a  
12 reapportionment plan. Changes of township, ward, or precinct  
13 lines shall not affect the terms of office of incumbent party  
14 committee members elected from districts as constituted at the  
15 time of their election."; and

16 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
