AN ACT

To amend chapter 8, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to energy efficiency improvements to certain state buildings.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 8, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 8.307, to read as follows:

8.307. 1. There is hereby established the "Capital Green 2 Program". Such program shall provide funding to the state:

3 (1) For weatherization and energy efficiency improvements to
4 the Missouri state capitol building and the governor's mansion; and

 $\mathbf{5}$ (2) For the exploration of potential pilot programs utilizing geothermal, wind, and solar energy resources and to install a network 6 7 of environmentally friendly free-flow turbine generators in the 8 Missouri river to provide electrical power for the Missouri state capitol building and the governor's mansion. Surplus energy, if generated, may 9 be used to provide power to the Harry S Truman office building, the 10 Missouri supreme court building, and the James C. Kirkpatrick state 11 information center. 12

132. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Capital Green Program Fund", which shall consist of money appropriated 14annually by the general assembly from general revenue and any gifts, 15bequests, or donations. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the 16 fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer 17 18 may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, 19 upon appropriation, money in the fund shall be used solely for the 20administration of this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of 21section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the

end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

26 **3. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:**

(1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this
section shall automatically sunset six years after the effective date of
this section unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly; and

30 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized 31 under this section shall automatically sunset twelve years after the 32 effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and

33 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the
34 calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the
35 program authorized under this section is sunset.
