### ANACT

To amend chapters 104 and 476, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to retirement benefits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 104 and 476, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto

- 2 two new sections, to be known as sections 104.1019 and 476.523, to read as
- 3 follows:

104.1019. 1. Any person who first became a member on or after

- August 28, 2013 and is receiving compensation under sections 104.1003
- 3 to 104.1093, or who is currently receiving benefits under sections
- 4 104.1003 to 104.1093 and who then becomes a full-time employee of a
- 5 city, town, village, or county of this state eligible to receive retirement
- 6 credits or benefits from that entity's retirement plan shall not receive
- 7 retirement compensation under sections 104.1003 to 104.1093 during the
- 8 period of employment by the city, town, village, or county.
- 9 2. Upon completion of such period of full-time employment the
- 10 member shall become eligible for retirement compensation under
- 11 sections 104.1003 to 104.1093 if the member is otherwise qualified as to
- 12 age and length of service.

476.523. Any judge who first became a judge on or after August

- 2 28, 2013 and is receiving compensation under sections 476.515 to
- 3 476.570, or who is currently receiving benefits under 476.515 to 476.570,
- 4 and who subsequently becomes employed as a full-time employee of a
- 5 political subdivision of this state, excluding public school districts,
- 6 eligible to participate in a retirement plan of the political subdivision
- 7 shall not receive retirement compensation under sections 476.515 to

8 476.570 for any calendar month in which the retired judge is so
