AN ACT

To amend chapter 477, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to judge disqualification.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 477, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 477.655, to read as follows:

477.655. 1. Any supreme, appellate, or circuit court judge who is appointed shall be disqualified from hearing a judicial proceeding or rendering a judgement in the following circumstances:

- (1) When a party or party's attorney to the proceeding before the judge was a member of the appellate judicial commission or a circuit judicial commission who nominated the judge; or
- 7 (2) When a party's attorney is currently employed by a firm 8 where a member of the appellate judicial commission or a circuit 9 judicial commission who nominated the judge is also currently 10 employed.
- 2. If a circuit judge is disqualified from hearing a case under the
- 12 provisions of this section, the court shall either call in another circuit
- 13 judge to sit in the case, as authorized by section 15 of article V of the
- 14 Missouri Constitution, or request the supreme court to transfer a judge
- 15 to hear the proceeding, as authorized by section 6 of article V of the
- 16 Missouri Constitution.
