## AN ACT

To repeal section 288.220, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to responsibilities of the division of employment security.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 288.220, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 288.220, to read as follows:

288.220. 1. Subject to the supervision of the director of the department

- 2 of labor and industrial relations, the division of employment security of the
- 3 department of labor and industrial relations shall be under the control,
- 4 management and supervision of a director who shall be appointed by the
- 5 governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate. The director shall
- 6 serve at the pleasure of the governor.
- 7 2. The division shall be responsible for administering the Missouri state
- 8 [employment service operation, the] unemployment insurance operation and any
- 9 other operations as are necessary to administer the state's employment security
- 10 law.
- 11 3. The central office of the division shall be maintained in the City of
- 12 Jefferson.
- 13 4. Subject to the supervision and approval of the director of the
- 14 department of labor and industrial relations, it shall be the duty of the director
- 15 to administer this law; and [he] the director shall have power and authority to
- 16 adopt, amend, or rescind any regulations as [he] the director deems necessary
- 17 to the efficient internal management of the division. The director shall determine
- 18 the division's organization and methods of procedure. Subject to the provisions
- 19 of the state merit system law, chapter 36, the director shall employ and prescribe

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20 the duties and powers of the persons as may be necessary. The director shall 21 collaborate with the personnel director and the personnel advisory board in 22 establishing for employees of the division salaries comparable to the salaries paid 23by other states of a similar size and volume of operations to employees engaged 24 in the administration of the employment security programs of those states. The director may delegate to any such person the power and authority as [he] the 2526 director deems reasonable and proper for the effective administration of the law, 27and may in his **or her** discretion bond any person handling moneys or signing 28 checks. Further, the director shall have the power to make expenditures, require 29 reports, make investigations and take other action not inconsistent with this law as [he] the director considers necessary to the efficient and proper 30 31 administration of the law.

5. Subject to the approval of the director of the department of labor and industrial relations and the commission, the director shall adopt, amend or rescind the rules and regulations as are necessary to implement any of the provisions of this law not relating to the internal management of the division; however, the rules and regulations shall not become effective until ten days after their approval by the commission and copies thereof have been filed in the office of the secretary of state.

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
