If any receiving district chooses to charge a rate of tuition that is at least thirty percent less than the rate of tuition that would otherwise be calculated under this subsection, then the statewide assessment scores and all other performance data for those students whom the district received shall not be used for five school years when calculating the performance of the receiving district for purposes of the Missouri school improvement program."; and further amend lines 41-45 by striking all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
