AN ACT

To repeal sections 105.010 and 252.002, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to gubernatorial appointments.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 105.010 and 252.002, RSMo, are repealed and three 2 new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 26.305, 105.010, and 3 252.002, to read as follows:

26.305. Whenever the governor shall appoint a department head $\mathbf{2}$ or a member of a board or commission pursuant to authority granted by section 51, article IV, of the Missouri Constitution, and such 3 appointment is denoted as an acting or otherwise temporary 4 appointment in the abstract maintained by the secretary of state under $\mathbf{5}$ section 28.060, and such appointment is not submitted to the senate for 6 7 its advice and consent, the authority of the acting or temporary department head or board or commission member shall terminate 8 according to the provisions of this section. For an acting department 9 10 head or member of a board or commission appointed when the senate 11 is in regular or special session, the authority of such person to act shall 12 terminate thirty days after the appointment or the final date of such session, whichever date comes first. For an acting department head or 1314 member of a board or commission appointed when the senate is not in 15 regular or special session, the authority of such person to act shall terminate thirty days after the senate has convened in the next regular 16or special session. Such acting appointee shall not be appointed by the 17

department or as an acting member of the same board or commission.

105.010. All officers elected or appointed by the authority of the laws of $\mathbf{2}$ this state shall hold their offices until their successors are elected or appointed, commissioned and qualified. For any person appointed by the governor to 3 a board or commission pursuant to authority granted by section 51, 4 article IV, of the Missouri Constitution, such appointee shall have 5authority to act during the pendency of the term of the office and for 6 up to sixty days after the expiration of the term of the office. If the 7governor fails to fill the vacancy created by the expiration of the term 8 9 of the office, then the board or commission position shall become vacant sixty days after the expiration of the person's term. 10

252.002. 1. There is hereby created a department of conservation to be headed by a conservation commission of four members appointed by the governor, $\mathbf{2}$ 3 by and with the advice and consent of the senate, not more than two of whom 4 shall be of the same political party. The members shall have the qualifications, serve the terms and receive the expense reimbursement provided in Article IV, 5Constitution of Missouri. The commission shall appoint a director of the 6 department of conservation who with its approval shall appoint assistants and 7 other employees. Any and all appointments made by the commission shall 8 be made by and with the advice and consent of the senate. 9

10 2. A majority of commissioners, three, shall constitute a quorum 11 for the transaction of business. If a quorum is not present, the 12 remaining members shall adjourn the meeting to a later time. No 13 business shall be transacted without a quorum.

All the powers, duties and functions of the conservation commission,
chapters 252, 254, and others, are transferred by type I transfer to the
department of conservation.
