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AN ACT

To amend chapter 135, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to incentives for interstate business relocation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 135, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 135.1670, to read as follows:

135.1670. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

2 (1) "Kansas border county", Douglas, Johnson, Miami, or
3 Wyandotte County in Kansas;

4 (2) "Missouri border county", any county with a charter form of government and with more than six hundred thousand but fewer than 5seven hundred thousand inhabitants, any county of the first 6 7 classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer than 8 ninety-two thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth 9 classification with more than four thousand five hundred but fewer 10 than five thousand inhabitants as the county seat, any county of the 11 first classification with more than two hundred thousand but fewer 12 than two hundred sixty thousand inhabitants, or any county of the first classification with more than ninety-two thousand but fewer than one 13hundred one thousand inhabitants in Missouri. 14

2. If any job that qualifies for a tax credit under sections 100.700 to 100.850 or under sections 135.100 to 135.258, for funding under section 620.1023, or for a tax credit or retention of state withholding taxes under sections 620.2000 to 620.2020, relocates to a Missouri border county from a Kansas border county, no tax credits shall be issued, funding provided, or retention of withholding taxes authorized for such 21 job under such sections.

223. If the director of the Missouri department of economic 23development determines that the state of Kansas has enacted legislation or the governor of Kansas issued an executive order or 24similar action which prohibits the Kansas Department of Commerce or 2526any other Kansas executive department from providing economic incentives for jobs that are relocated from a Missouri border county to 2728a Kansas border county, then the director shall execute and deliver to 29the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such 30 determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such written 31certification and the parties receiving such certification providing a 32unanimous written affirmation, the provisions of subsection 2 of this 33 section shall be effective unless otherwise provided in this section. The 34provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall not apply to incentives 35 reserved on behalf of and awarded to Missouri employers prior to the 36 37 provisions of subsection 2 of this section taking effect.

38 4. If the director of the Missouri department of economic 39 development determines that the Kansas Department of Commerce or 40 any other Kansas executive department is providing economic incentives for jobs that relocate from a Missouri border county to a 41 42 Kansas border county, then the director shall execute and deliver to 43the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the 44 president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such 45determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such written 46 certification and the parties receiving such certification providing a unanimous written affirmation, the provisions of subsection 2 of this 47section shall not be effective until such time as the director determines 48 that the Kansas Department of Commerce, or any other Kansas 49 executive department is not providing economic incentives for jobs that 50relocate from a Missouri border county to a Kansas border county, and 5152the director has executed and delivered to the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the 53senate a written certification of such determination and the parties 54receiving such certification provide a unanimous written affirmation. 555. The director of the Missouri department of economic 56development shall notify the revisor of statutes of all changes in 57

58 whether subsection 2 of this section is effective.

59 6. The provisions of this section shall expire August 28, 2016,

- 60 unless at such time the provisions of subsection 2 of this section are in
- 61 effect. If the provisions of this section do not expire on August 28, 2016,

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62 the provisions of this section shall expire on August 28, 2020.
