Amend \_\_\_\_\_ House \_\_\_\_\_ Bill No. 515, Page 1, Section Title, Line 3,

2 by striking the word "police" and inserting in lieu thereof the  
 3 following: "local government"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 86.200, line 114,  
 5 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

6 "86.207. 1. Except as provided herein, all persons who  
 7 become policemen and all policemen who enter or reenter the  
 8 service of [the] any city not within a county after the first day  
 9 of October, 1957, become members as a condition of their  
 10 employment and shall receive no pensions or retirement allowance  
 11 from any other pension or retirement system supported wholly or  
 12 in part by the city not within a county or the state of Missouri,  
 13 nor shall they be required to make contributions under any other  
 14 pension or retirement system of the city not within a county or  
 15 the state of Missouri for the same period of service, anything to  
 16 the contrary notwithstanding. Any employee of a city not within  
 17 a county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan  
 18 established by said city under section 95.540 and subsequently  
 19 becomes a policeman may elect to remain a member of said  
 20 retirement plan and shall not be required to become a member of a  
 21 police retirement system established under section 86.200.  
 22 However, an employee of a city not within a county who is earning

1 creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city  
2 under section 95.540 and who subsequently becomes a policeman may  
3 elect to transfer membership and creditable service to the police  
4 retirement system created under section 86.200. Such transfers  
5 are subject to the conditions and requirements contained in  
6 section 105.691 and are also subject to any existing agreements  
7 between the said retirement plans; provided however, transfers  
8 completed prior to January 1, 2016, shall occur without regard to  
9 the vesting requirements of the receiving plan contained in  
10 section 105.691. As part of the transfer process described  
11 herein, the respective retirement plans may require the employee  
12 to acknowledge and agree as a condition of transfer that any  
13 election made under this section is irrevocable, constitutes a  
14 waiver of any right to receive retirement and disability benefits  
15 except as provided by the police retirement system, and that plan  
16 terms may be modified in the future.

17 2. If any member ceases to be in service for more than one  
18 year unless the member has attained the age of fifty-five or has  
19 twenty years or more of creditable service, or if the member  
20 withdraws the member's accumulated contributions or if the member  
21 receives benefits under the retirement system or dies, the member  
22 thereupon ceases to be a member; except in the case of a member  
23 who has served in the Armed Forces of the United States and has  
24 subsequently been reinstated as a policeman. A member who has  
25 terminated employment as a police officer, has actually retired  
26 and is receiving retirement benefits under the system shall be  
27 considered a retired member.

28 3. A reserve officer shall not be considered a member of  
29 the system for the purpose of determining creditable service, nor

1 shall any contributions be due. A reserve officer shall not be  
2 entitled to any benefits from the system other than those awarded  
3 when the reserve officer originally retired under section 86.250,  
4 nor shall service as a reserve officer prohibit distribution of  
5 those benefits."; and

6 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.  
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
