10	shall conduct data matches using the name, date of birth,
11	address, Social Security number of each applicant and recipient,
12	and additional data provided by the applicant or recipient
13	relevant to eligibility against public records and other data
14	sources to verify eligibility data.
15	2. The contractor shall evaluate the income, resources, and
16	assets of each applicant and recipient no less than quarterly.
17	In addition to quarterly eligibility data verification, the
18	contractor shall identify on a monthly basis any program
19	participants who have died, moved out of state, or have been
20	incarcerated longer than ninety days.
21	3. The contractor, upon completing an eligibility data
22	verification of an applicant or recipient, shall notify the

department of the results, except that the contractor shall not verify the eliqibility data of persons residing in long-term care facilities whose income and resources were at or below the applicable financial eliqibility standards at the time of their last review. Within twenty business days of such notification, the department shall make an eliqibility determination. The department shall retain final authority over eliqibility determinations. The contractor shall keep a record of all eliqibility data verifications communicated to the department.

4. Within thirty days of the end of each calendar year, the department and contractor shall file a joint report on a yearly basis to the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate.

The report shall include, but shall not be limited to, the number of applicants and recipients determined ineligible for assistance programs based on the eligibility data verification by the contractor and the stated reasons for the determination of ineligibility by the department."; and
