

SENATE SUBSTITUTE

SENATE BILL NO. 373

AN ACT

To repeal section 311.730, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the establishment of the division of alcohol and tobacco control fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI,
AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section A. Section 311.730, RSMo, is repealed and two new
2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 311.730
3 and 311.735, to read as follows:

4 311.730. 1. Except as otherwise provided under subsection
5 2 of this section, all fees collected by the director of revenue
6 as provided for in this chapter, including licenses, inspection
7 and gauging fees, shall be paid into the state treasury, to the
8 credit of the ordinary state revenue fund.

9 2. Seventy percent of all fees for licenses and permits
10 collected under this chapter shall be paid to the credit of the
11 division of alcohol and tobacco control fund established under
12 section 311.735.

13 311.735. 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury
14 the "Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control Fund". The state
15 treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with
16 sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve
17 disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon
18 appropriation, money in the fund shall be used solely by the

1 division of alcohol and tobacco control for the administration of
2 this chapter and sections 407.925 to 407.934, and any duties
3 under such chapter and sections relating to licensing, training,
4 technical assistance, and regulations.

5 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the
6 contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the
7 biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue
8 fund.

9 3. Appropriation of funds by the general assembly from the
10 fund shall be used to support the division of alcohol and tobacco
11 control for the purposes provided under subsection 1 of this
12 section.
