## AN ACT

To repeal section 304.154, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to tow truck operations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 304.154, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 304.154, to read as follows:

304.154. 1. [Beginning January 1, 2005,] A towing company operating a tow truck pursuant to the authority granted in section **304.153**, 304.155, or

- 3 304.157 shall:
- 4 (1) Have and occupy a verifiable business address and display such 5 address in a location visible from the street or road;
- 6 (2) Have a fenced, secure, and lighted storage lot or an enclosed, secure building for the storage of motor vehicles, with a total area for storing vehicles, either inside or outside, of at least two thousand square feet
- 9 and fencing a minimum of seven feet high;
- 10 (3) Be open for a minimum of eight hours per day between the 11 hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday for a customer 12 or his authorized agent to view and retrieve a vehicle, with no 13 additional fees charged to view or retrieve a vehicle during these
- 14 regular business hours;
- 15 (4) Be available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Availability
- 16 shall mean that an employee of the towing company or an answering service
- 17 answered by a person is able to respond to a tow request;
- 18 (5) Have and maintain an operational telephone with the

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telephone number published or available through directory assistance;

- 20 [(4)] (6) Maintain a valid insurance policy issued by an insurer authorized to do business in this state, or a bond or other acceptable surety 2122providing coverage for the death of, or injury to, persons and damage to property 23 for each accident or occurrence in the amount of at least five hundred thousand dollars per incident; 24
- 25 [(5)] (7) Provide workers' compensation insurance for all employees of the towing company if required by chapter 287; and 26
- 27 [(6)] (8) Maintain current motor vehicle registrations on all tow trucks 28 currently operated within the towing company fleet.
- 29 2. The initial tow performed under sections 304.153, 304.155, or 30 304.157 shall remain in the state of Missouri unless authorized by the 31 vehicle owner or their agent.
- 32 3. Tows performed under section 304.155 shall not be dispatched through a third party dispatch system or management company, unless 33 hired by the towing company. The provisions of this subsection shall 34 not apply to any home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county. 36
- 37 4. Counties may adopt ordinances with respect to towing company standards in addition to the minimum standards contained in this section. A 38 towing company located in a county of the second, third, [and] or fourth 39 40 classification or located in any county of the first classification with more than one hundred one thousand but fewer than one hundred 41 fifteen thousand inhabitants is exempt from the provisions of this section.
