AN ACT

To repeal section 57.111, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the authority of sheriffs and deputy sheriffs to render assistance in other counties.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.111, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 57.111, to read as follows:

57.111. Whenever any sheriff or deputy sheriff of any county in this state
2 is expressly requested, in each instance, by a sheriff [of an adjoining county] of
3 this state to render assistance, such sheriff or deputy shall have the same powers
4 of arrest in such county as he **or she** has in his **or her** own jurisdiction. **For**
5 **purposes of liability, any sheriff or deputy sheriff of a county**
6 **responding to a request for assistance in another county of the state**
7 **shall be deemed an employee of the responding county sheriff's office**
8 **and shall be subject to the liability and workers' compensation,**
9 **overtime, and expense reimbursement provisions provided to him or**
10 **her as an employee of his or her sheriff's office.**
