AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to healthy behavior incentives for MO HealthNet recipients.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 208.445, to read as follows:

208.445. 1. As used in this section, "MO HealthNet managed care 2 organization" means a managed care organization under the MO 3 HealthNet program.

2. Each MO HealthNet managed care organization in this state shall, through an existing healthy behavior incentive program or establishment of a new healthy behavior incentive program, increase the limits of or allow for the combining of any or all healthy behavior incentive credits, moneys, reimbursement, or other similar rewards for covered recipients in an amount sufficient to include the purchase of the following infant and childcare items:

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(1) Infant and child car seats;

(2) Playpens, safety gates and door barriers, and other similar
safety items designed to provide a secure environment for infants and
toddlers;

(3) Diaper bags and diaper bags with diaper changing supplies
 included;

(4) Any other similar infant and childcare items, as designated
by rule of the MO HealthNet division, that encourage healthy behaviors
which improve the health and safety of infants and children.

20 **3.** The MO HealthNet division shall promulgate rules to 21 implement the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, 22 as that term is defined in section 536.010 that is created under the 23authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it 24complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, 25if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are 26nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly 27pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to 28disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, 29then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void. 30
