### AN ACT

To amend chapters 104 and 476, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to retirement benefits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 104 and 476, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto

- 2 two new sections, to be known as sections 104.1019 and 476.523, to read as
- 3 follows:
- 104.1019. 1. Any person who is a retiree and is receiving
- 2 retirement benefits under sections 104.1003 to 104.1093 and who is or
- 3 becomes a full-time employee of a political subdivision of this state,
- 4 excluding public school districts, eligible to participate in a retirement
- 5 plan of the political subdivision shall not receive retirement benefits
- 6 under sections 104.1003 to 104.1093 during the period of employment by
- 7 the political subdivision.
- Upon completion of such period of full-time employment, the
- 9 retiree shall become eligible for retirement benefits under sections
- 10 104.1003 to 104.1093, if the retiree is otherwise qualified as to age and
- 11 length of service.
  - 476.523. 1. Any retired judge who is receiving retirement
  - 2 benefits under 476.515 to 476.570 and who is or becomes a full-time
  - 3 employee of a political subdivision of this state, excluding public school
  - 4 districts, eligible to participate in a retirement plan of the political
  - 5 subdivision shall not receive retirement benefits under sections 476.515
- 6 to 476.570 during the period of employment by the political subdivision.
- 7 2. Upon completion of such period of full-time employment, the
- 3 retired judge shall become eligible for retirement benefits under
- 9 sections 476.515 to 476.570, if the retired judge is otherwise qualified
