AN ACT

To amend chapter 477, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to judge disqualification.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 477, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 477.655, to read as follows:

section, to be known as section 477.655, to read as follows:

477.655. 1. Any supreme, appellate, or circuit court judge who is

- appointed shall be disqualified from hearing a judicial proceeding or
- 3 rendering a judgment when a party or party's attorney to the
- 4 proceeding before the judge was a member of the appellate judicial
- 5 commission or a circuit judicial commission who nominated the judge.
- 6 In the event that a party or party's attorney was a member of the
- 7 commission who nominated the judge hearing the judicial proceeding,
- 8 then the party or party's attorney shall disclose such information to the
- 9 judge and the opposing party.
- 2. If recusal of the judge is required pursuant to subsection 1 of
- 11 this section, then the opposing party may waive the recusal and the
- 12 judge may participate in the proceeding, subject to the judge's
- 13 agreement. Such waiver shall be incorporated into the record.
- 3. If a circuit judge is disqualified from hearing a case under the
- 15 provisions of this section, the court shall either call in another circuit
- 16 judge to sit in the case, as authorized by section 15 of article V of the
- 17 Missouri Constitution, or request the supreme court to transfer a judge
- 18 to hear the proceeding, as authorized by section 6 of article V of the
- 19 Missouri Constitution.
