AN ACT

To amend chapter 565, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to capital punishment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 565, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 565.047, to read as follows:

565.047. 1. There is hereby established a "Task Force on the

- 2 Death Penalty". The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 3 (1) One member of the general assembly appointed by the 4 president pro tempore of the senate;
- 5 (2) One member of the general assembly appointed by the 6 minority floor leader of the senate;
- 7 (3) One member of the general assembly appointed by the 8 speaker of the house of representatives;
- 9 (4) One member of the general assembly appointed by the 10 minority floor leader of the house of representatives;
- 11 (5) Two members of a team, which assessed the state's death
- 12 penalty system with the support of a national association of attorneys
- 13 and, in conjunction with the association, issued a report in 2012 on
- 14 issues central to the analysis of the fairness and accuracy of the state's
- 15 capital punishment system, to be appointed by the governor with the
- 16 advice and consent of the senate;
- 17 (6) A circuit court judge, to be appointed by the chief justice of 18 the Missouri supreme court;
- 19 (7) The president of the Missouri association of prosecuting 20 attorneys or his or her designee;
- 21 (8) The president of the Missouri association of criminal defense

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- 22 lawyers or his or her designee;
- 23 (9) The director of the Missouri state public defender system or
- 24 his or her designee; and
- 25 (10) The attorney general or his or her designee.
- 26 2. The task force shall be appointed on or before December 1,
- 27 2015. At the first meeting, the task force shall elect a chairperson.
- 3. The members of the task force shall serve without
- 29 compensation, but the members shall be reimbursed for necessary
- 30 expenses incurred in the work of the task force.
- 31 4. The task force shall analyze issues relating to the state's
- 32 capital punishment system, including the 2012 Missouri Death Penalty
- 33 Assessment Report published by the American Bar Association and its
- 34 recommendations for promoting greater fairness and accuracy in the
- 35 application of the death penalty. Task force members shall identify
- 36 policies to prevent wrongful convictions and promote fairness in the
- 37 Missouri capital punishment system.
- 38 5. The task force shall report its policy recommendations to the
- 39 governor, the president pro tempore of the senate, the speaker of the
- 40 house of representatives, and the chief justice of the Missouri supreme
- 41 court by January 1, 2018. The task force shall expire January 1, 2018.
- 6. Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or chapter 546
- 43 to the contrary, no execution of a defendant shall take place from
- 44 August 28, 2015, to January 1, 2018. However, during such period, the
- 45 special procedures in cases of first degree murder provided in sections
- 46 565.030 to 565.040 and any other proceedings related to capital cases,
- 47 including motions for postconviction relief, shall continue to be
- 48 operative and shall proceed as if no such moratorium were in place,
- 49 except that no day certain for execution shall be appointed from August
- 50 28, 2015, to January 1, 2018.

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
