AN ACT

To amend chapter 173, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to curriculum for degrees offered by public colleges and universities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 173, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 173.925, to read as follows:

173.925. 1. The provisions of this section shall be known as the ² "Curriculum Transparency Act". For purposes of this section, the ³ following terms mean:

- 4 (1) "Person", any individual, corporation, partnership, 5 association, or business entity of any kind or description; and
- 6 (2) "Public colleges and universities", any college or university 7 established under chapters 172, 174, 175, sections 178.631 to 178.640, or 8 sections 178.770 to 178.891.
- 2. Each public college and university shall post on its internet website information for each course offered at the college or university that includes the course's syllabus, reading list, attendance requirements, extra credit opportunities, and a description of required assignments and projects.
- 3. The information identified in subsection 2 of this section shall be considered public information that is available to any person who requests it.
