AN ACT

To amend chapter 198, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to long-term care facilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 198, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 198.053, to read as follows:

198.053. Every year, all long-term care facilities licensed under this chapter shall offer, at the facility itself, vaccinations for the influenza virus for its health care workers and other employees who have direct contact with patients, unless contraindicated, in accordance with the latest recommendations of the Centers of Disease, Control and Prevention, subject to availability of the vaccine. Each facility shall maintain a record of a signed statement from each health care worker and employee stating that he or she has been offered a vaccination against the influenza virus and has either accepted or declined such vaccination.
