AN ACT

To amend chapter 292, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to workplace violence, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 292, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 292.670, to read as follows:

292.670. 1. In order to protect the safety and identity of employees and members of the public, no employer shall:

- 3 (1) Transmit an employee's or customer's full name on any 4 address system that is used to announce information to the general 5 public;
- 6 (2) Provide an employee's work schedule to any person other 7 than the employee or the employee's designee;
- 8 (3) Provide an employee's personal information such as a home 9 address or telephone number to any person not working for the 10 employer without the employee's previous consent.
- 2. Any person or entity that violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a class B misdemeanor and shall be civilly liable for any damages incurred as a direct result of the
- 14 violation.
- 3. No owner, employer, or management personnel of a business or establishment subject to the provisions of this section who directs or exercises any authority in a facility shall evict, harass, dismiss, or retaliate against an employee or patron of the business or establishment because such employee or patron has made a report of
