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



Comprehensive Medicaid Managed Care Models in the States, 2015




MCO Penetration Rates for Select Groups of Medicaid Beneficiaries, July 2015


Services Covered in State Medicaid Managed Care Contracts







State Delivery System Reform Initiatives FY 2015 and FY2016




