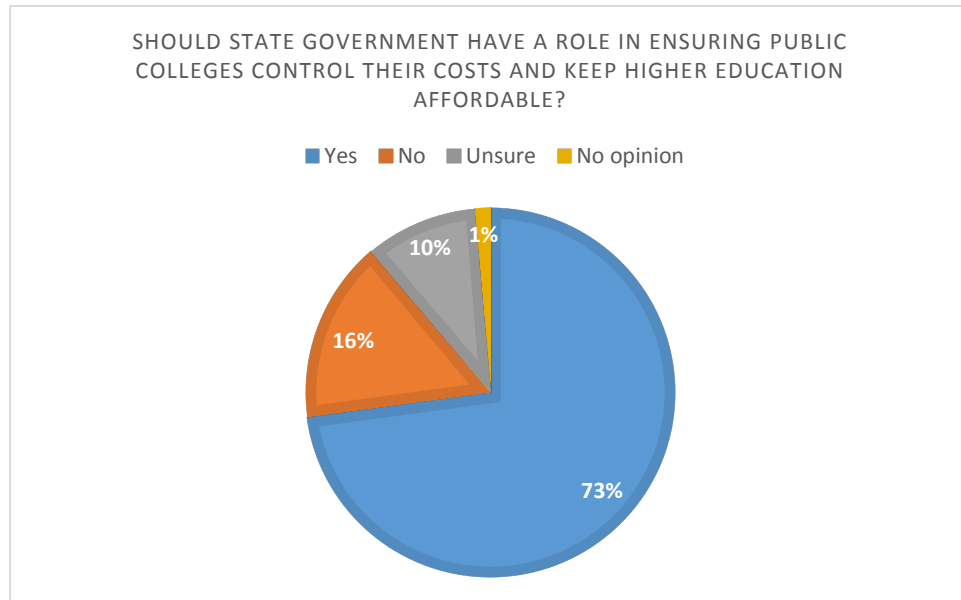

Should state government have a role in ensuring public colleges control their costs and keep higher education affordable?

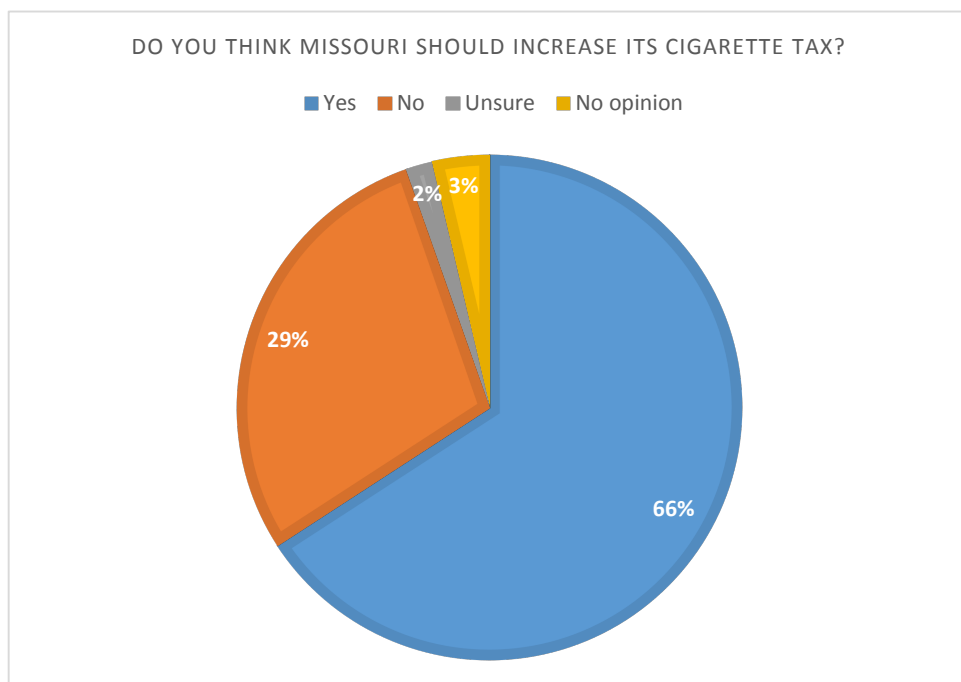

Cigarette Tax

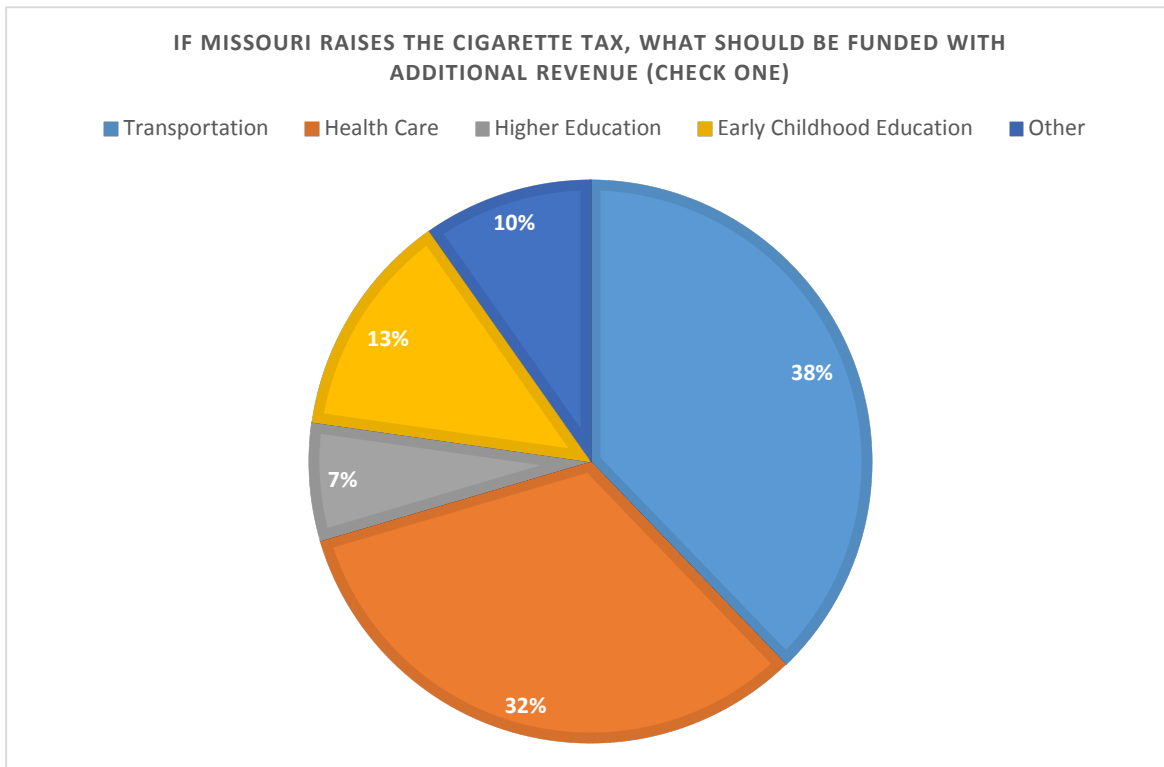
Do you think Missouri should increase its cigarette tax?

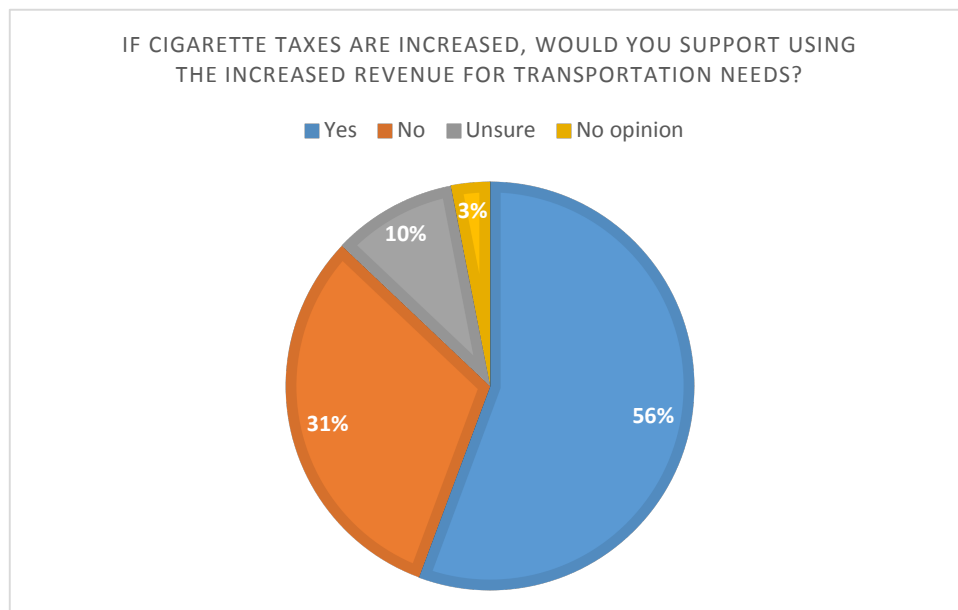
If Missouri raises the cigarette tax, what should be funded with additional revenue (Check one)

If cigarette taxes are increased, would you support using the increased revenue for transportation needs?

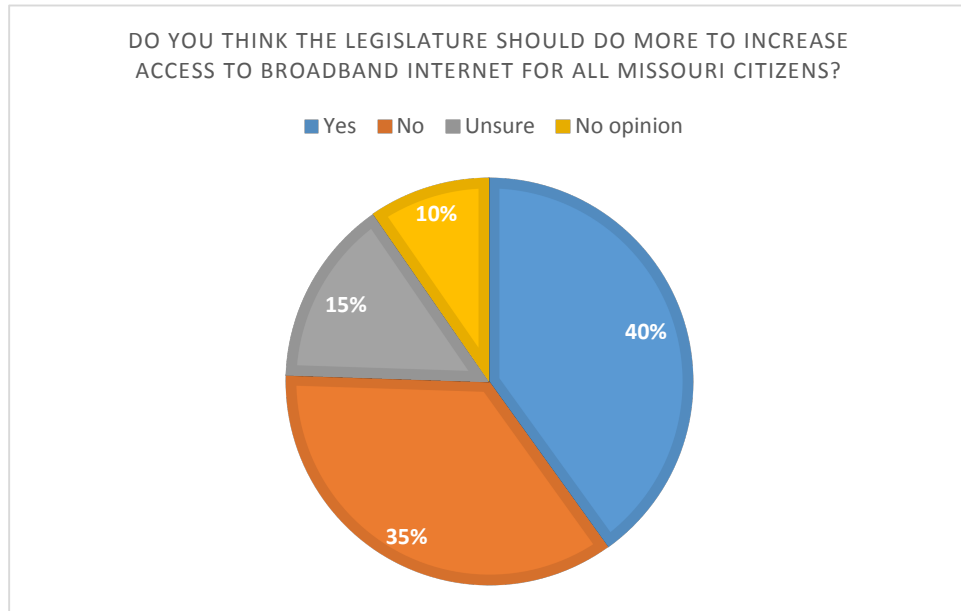

Do you think the Legislature should do more to increase access to broadband internet for all Missouri citizens?

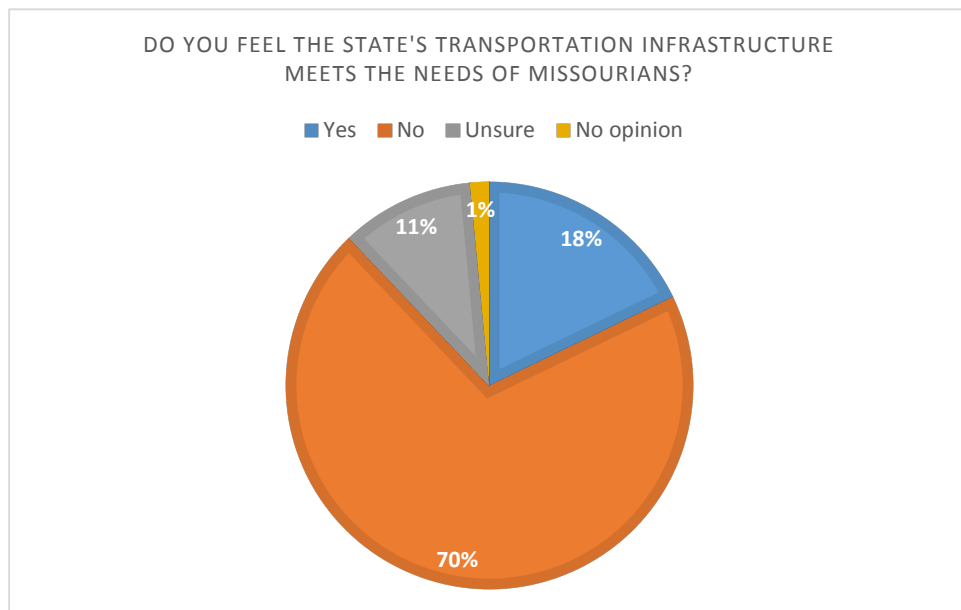

Do you feel the state's transportation infrastructure meets the needs of Missourians?

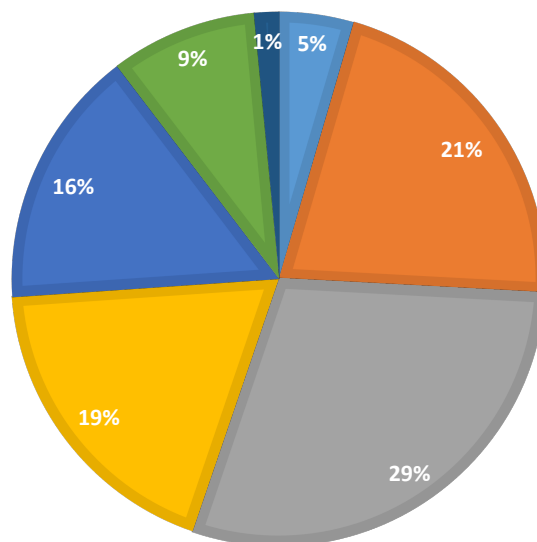
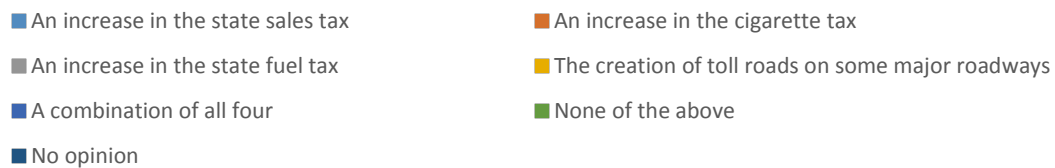

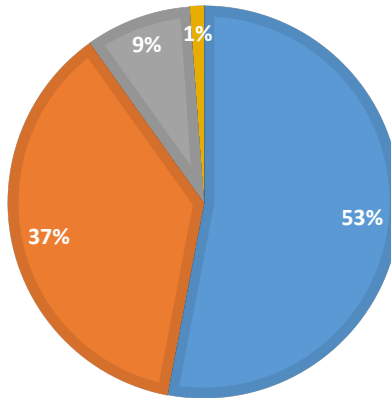


Do you think Missouri should use tolls to pay for repairs to I-70?

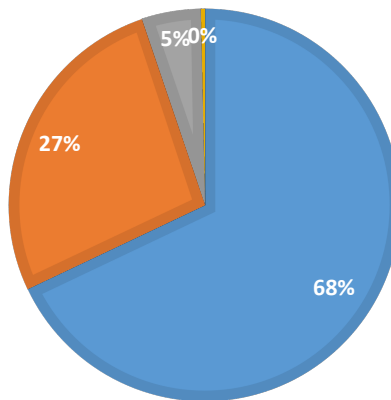


Would you support a gas tax increase of two cents to help fund highway infrastructure?

FUND HIGHWAY INFRASTRUCTURE?

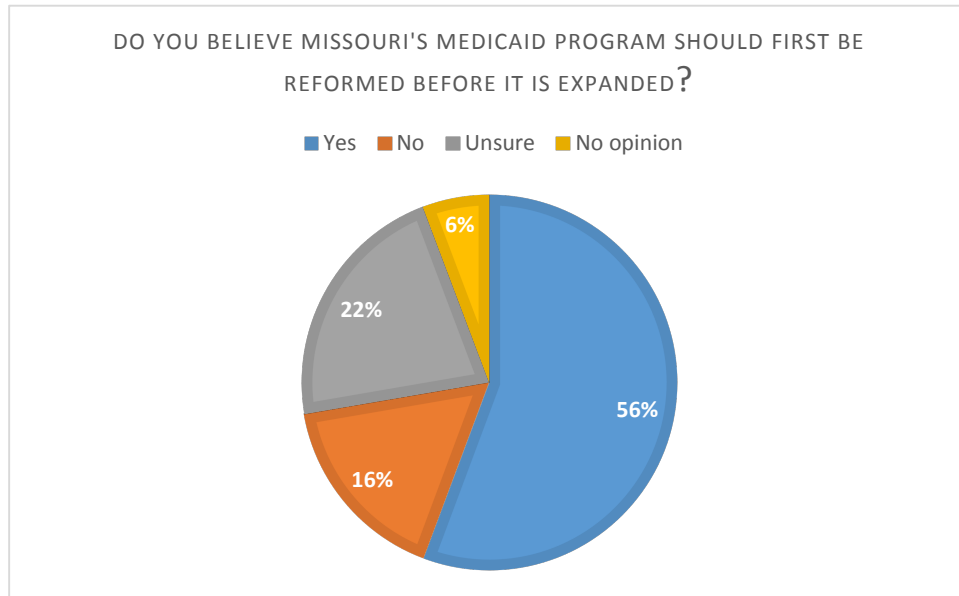

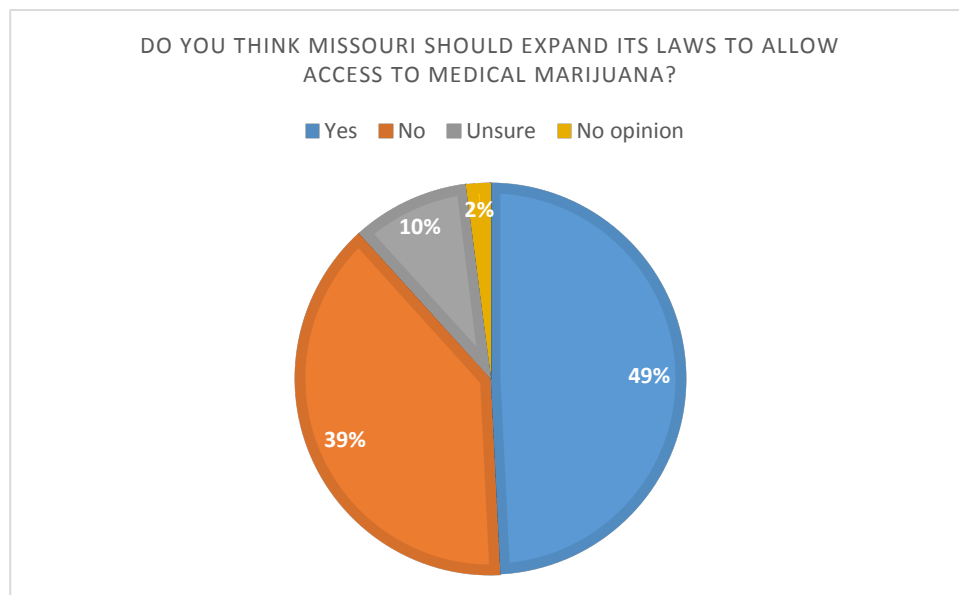
Do you believe Missouri's Medicaid program should first be reformed before it is expanded?

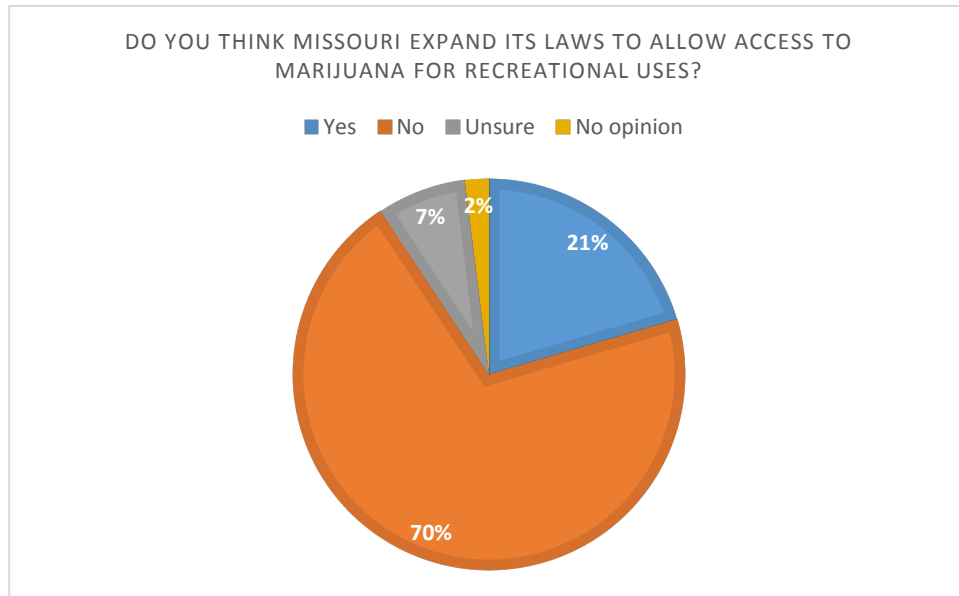
Do you think Missouri should expand its laws to allow access to medical marijuana?

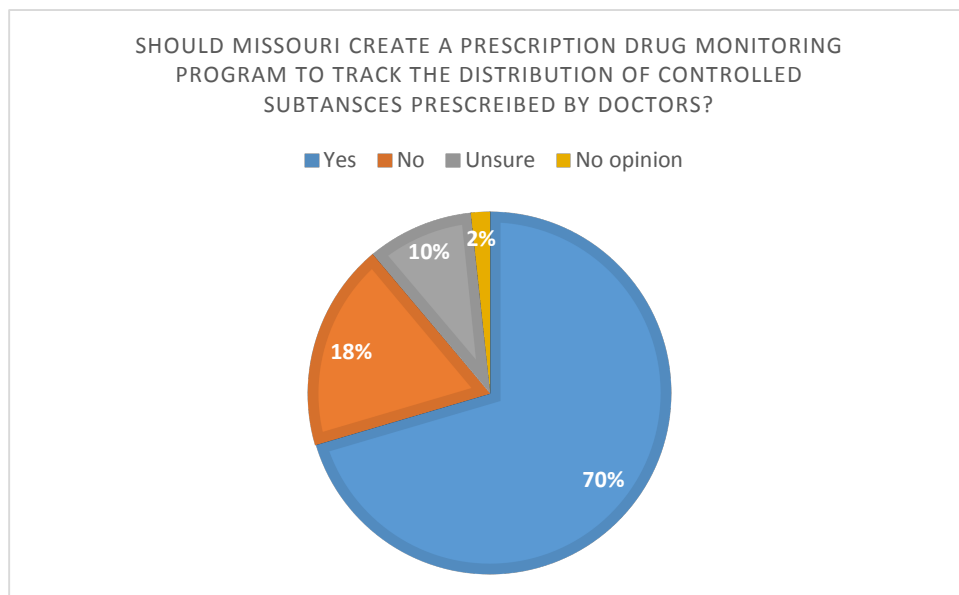
Do you think Missouri expand its laws to allow access to marijuana for recreational uses?

Should Missouri create a prescription drug monitoring program to track the distribution of controlled substances prescribed by doctors?

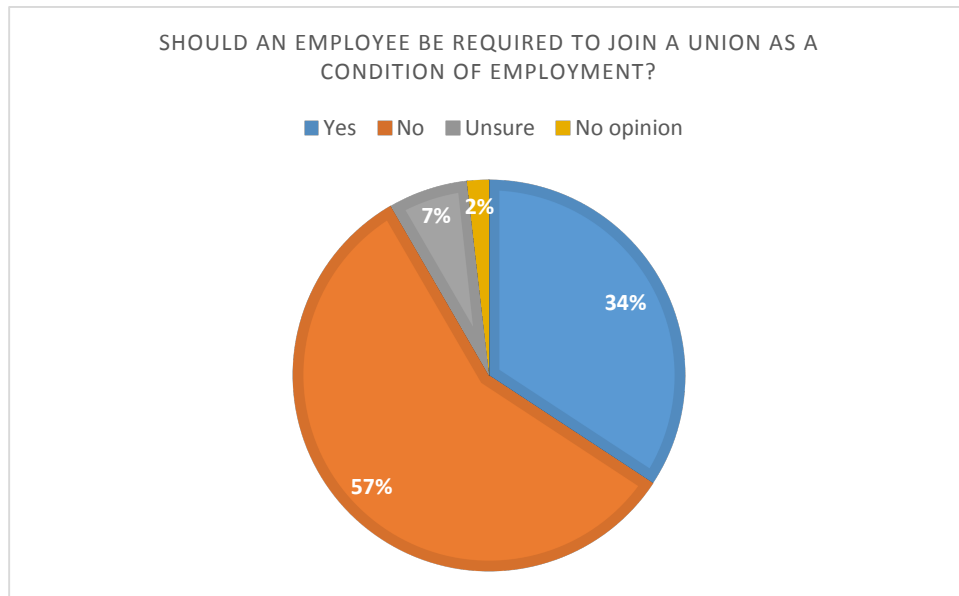

Should an employee be required to join a union as a condition of employment?

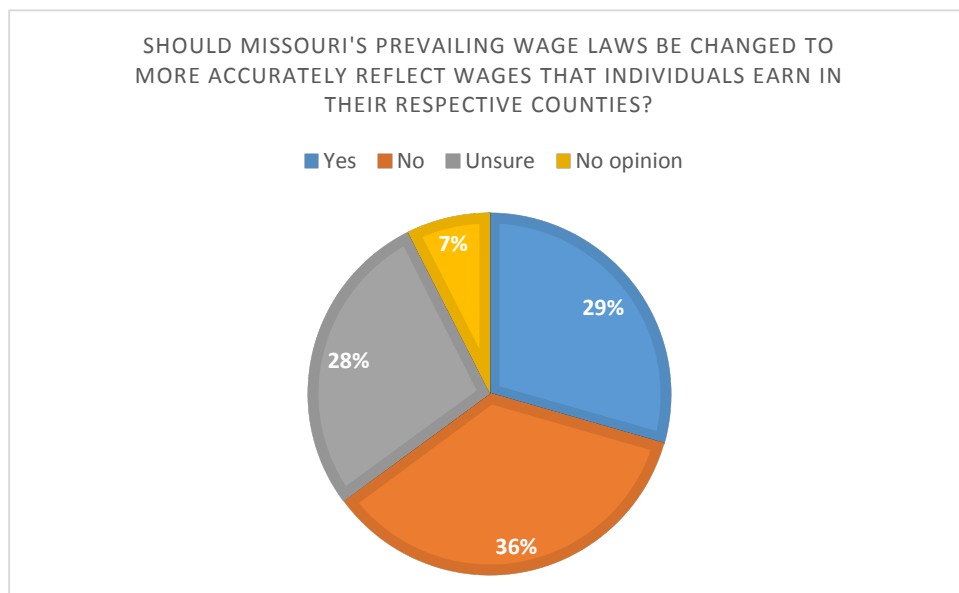

Should Missouri's prevailing wage laws be changed to more accurately reflect wages that individuals earn in their respective counties?

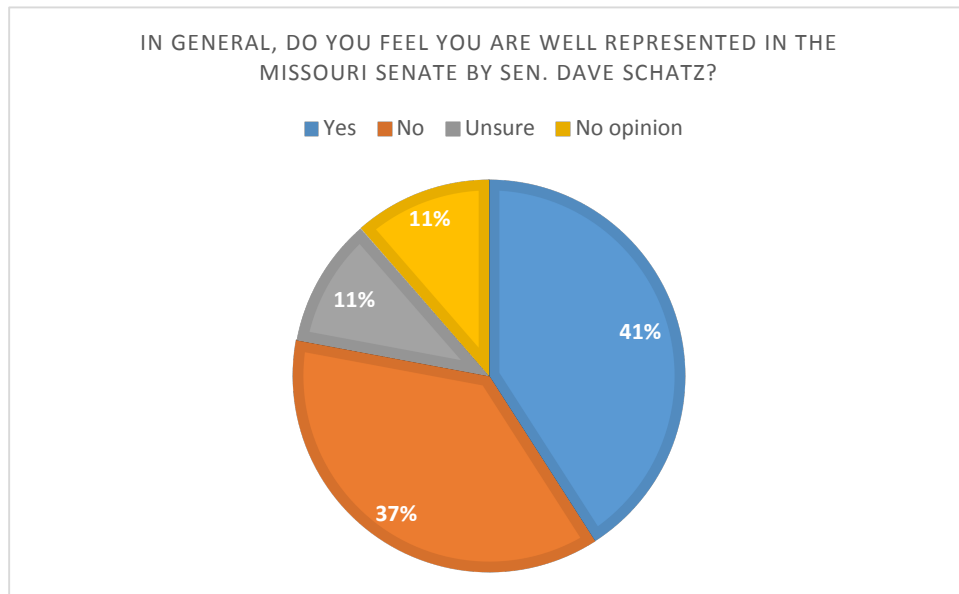

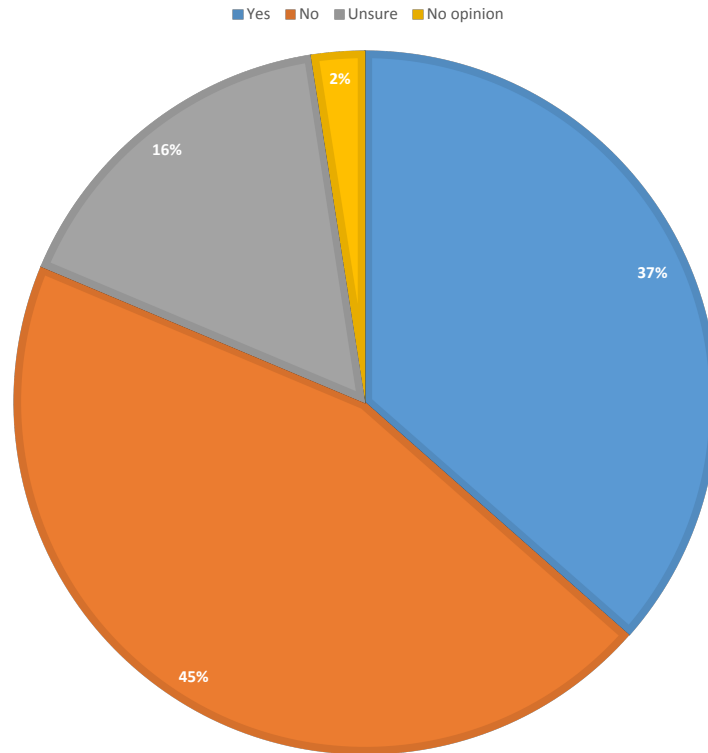


National Popular Vote

National popular vote would guarantee the presidency to the candidate who receives the most popular votes in the country. This legislation has been enacted into law in 11 states with 165 electoral votes and will take effect when enacted by states with 105 more electoral votes, for a total of 270, the majority needed to elect a president. National popular vote would not require a constitutional amendment as states currently have the power to assign their electoral college votes.
