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## AN ACT

To repeal section 479.372, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to municipal courts.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 479.372, RSMo, is repealed and one new section  
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 479.372, to read as follows:

479.372. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section  
2 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in sections 479.350 to  
3 479.372 shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the  
4 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. [This section]  
5 **Sections 479.350 to 479.372** and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the  
6 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to  
7 delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held  
8 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed  
9 or adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void.
