AN ACT

To repeal section 479.372, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to municipal courts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 479.372, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 479.372, to read as follows:

479.372. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section

- 2 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in sections 479.350 to
- 3 479.372 shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
- 4 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. [This section]
- 5 Sections 479.350 to 479.372 and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the
- 6 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to
- 7 delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
- 8 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed
- 9 or adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void.
