Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 302 & 228 , Page 4 , Section 57.530 , Line 17

2 of said page, by inserting immediately after said line the  
 3 following:

4 "86.207. 1. Except as provided herein, all persons who  
 5 become policemen and all policemen who enter or reenter the  
 6 service of any city not within a county after the first day of  
 7 October, 1957, become members of the system as a condition of  
 8 their employment and during the period of their membership shall  
 9 receive no pensions or retirement allowance from any other  
 10 pension or retirement system supported wholly or in part by the  
 11 city not within a county or the state of Missouri, nor shall they  
 12 be required to make contributions under any other pension or  
 13 retirement system of the city not within a county or the state of  
 14 Missouri for the same period of service[, anything to the  
 15 contrary notwithstanding. Any employee of a city not within a  
 16 county who is earning creditable service in a retirement plan  
 17 established by said city under section 95.540 and subsequently  
 18 becomes a policeman may elect to remain a member of said  
 19 retirement plan and shall not be required to become a member of a  
 20 police retirement system established under section 86.200.  
 21 However,]. Officers employed by a city not within a county and

1 occupying the position of "Airport Police Officer" shall not be  
2 required to become members as a condition of their employment.

3 An employee of a city not within a county who is earning  
4 creditable service in a retirement plan established by said city  
5 under section 95.540 and who subsequently becomes a policeman may  
6 elect to transfer [membership and] creditable service to the  
7 police retirement system created under [section] sections 86.200  
8 to 86.366. Such transfers are subject to the conditions and  
9 requirements contained in section 105.691 and are also subject to  
10 any existing agreements between the said retirement plans[;  
11 provided however, transfers completed prior to January 1, 2016,  
12 shall occur without regard to the vesting requirements of the  
13 receiving plan contained in section 105.691]. As part of the  
14 transfer process described herein, the respective retirement  
15 plans may require the employee to acknowledge and agree as a  
16 condition of transfer that any election made under this section  
17 is irrevocable, constitutes a waiver of any right to receive  
18 retirement and disability benefits except as provided by the  
19 police retirement system, and that plan terms may be modified in  
20 the future.

21 2. If any member ceases to be in service for more than one  
22 year unless the member has attained the age of fifty-five or has  
23 twenty years or more of creditable service, or if the member  
24 withdraws the member's accumulated contributions or if the member  
25 receives benefits under the retirement system or dies, the member  
26 thereupon ceases to be a member; except in the case of a member

1 who has served in the Armed Forces of the United States and has  
2 subsequently been reinstated as a policeman. A member who has  
3 terminated employment as a police officer, has actually retired  
4 and is receiving retirement benefits under the system shall be  
5 considered a retired member.

6 3. A reserve officer shall not be considered a member of  
7 the system for the purpose of determining creditable service, nor  
8 shall any contributions be due. A reserve officer shall not be  
9 entitled to any benefits from the system other than those awarded  
10 when the reserve officer originally retired under section 86.250,  
11 nor shall service as a reserve officer prohibit distribution of  
12 those benefits."; and

13 Further amend said bill, page 33, section B, line 26 by  
14 inserting after the word "position," the following: "to meet the  
15 requirements of the Social Security Administration and to prevent  
16 the expulsion of Missouri airport officers from the Social  
17 Security Program,"; and further amend line 28 of said page, by  
18 inserting immediately after "57.530," the following: "86.207,";

20 Further amend said bill and section, page 34, line 5 of said  
21 page, by inserting immediately after "57.530," the following:  
22 "86.207,"; and

23 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
