5	System Oversight Committee", whose primary duty shall be to

9	system and revise its criteria and procedures in cooperation with
10	the department of public safety to provide for efficient and
11	effective public notification and meet at least annually to
12	discuss potential improvements to the Amber alert system. As
13	soon as practicable, the committee shall adopt criteria and
14	procedures to expand the Amber alert system to provide urgent
15	public alerts related to homeland security, criminal acts, health
16	emergencies, and other imminent dangers to the public health and
17	welfare.
18	2. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall consist
19	of ten members of which seven members shall be appointed by the
20	governor with the advice and consent of the senate. Such members
21	shall represent the following entities: two representatives of

the Missouri Sheriffs' Association; two representatives of the

Missouri Police Chiefs Association; one representative of small

market radio broadcasters; one representative of large market radio broadcasters; one representative of television broadcasters. The director of the department of public safety shall also be a member of the committee and shall serve as chair of the committee. Additional members shall include one representative of the highway patrol and one representative of the department of health and senior services.

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- 3. Members of the oversight committee shall serve a term of four years, except that members first appointed to the committee shall have staggered terms of two, three, and four years and shall serve until their successor is duly appointed and qualified.
- 4. Members of the oversight committee shall serve without compensation, except that members shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses required for the discharge of their duties.
- 5. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall promulgate rules for the implementation of the Amber alert system. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2003, shall be invalid and void.
