FULL FUNDING FOR THE MISSOURI RX PROGRAM

House Bill 412 extends the expiration date for the Missouri Rx Plan (MoRx) from Aug. 28, 2011, to Aug. 28, 2014. MoRx is Missouri's State Pharmacy Assistance Program and assists thousands of citizens each year in their effort to afford their medications. Created more than five years ago by the 93rd General Assembly, this beneficial program helps provide prescription drug assistance to Missourians in need by coordinating benefits with Medicare's Part D Prescription Drug Program.

CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX CREDIT CONTINUES

The Legislature also continued to fund Missouri's Property Tax Credit, also known as the Circuit Breaker Tax Credit. This tax credit allows certain senior citizens and 100 percent disabled individuals to claim a portion of the real estate taxes or rent they have paid for the year. The credit is for a maximum of \$750 for renters and \$1,100 for owners who own and occupy their home. The chart below shows the qualifications for the Circuit Breaker Tax Credit.
