AN ACT

To repeal section 163.016, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the dollar value modifier used in certain school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 163.016, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 163.016, to read as follows:

163.016. **1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section 163.011, for any 2 school district located in more than one county and whose headquarters are 3 located within a city of the fourth classification with more than two thousand five 4 hundred but fewer than two thousand six hundred inhabitants and located in 5 more than one county, the county signified in the school district number shall be 6 the county in the district with the highest dollar value modifier.

7 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 163.011, for any 8 school district located in more than one county and whose headquarters are located within a city of the fourth classification with 9 more than two thousand four hundred but fewer than two thousand 10 seven hundred inhabitants and located in any county of the third 11 12 classification without a township form of government and with more 13 than fourteen thousand but fewer than sixteen thousand inhabitants 14 and that is not the county seat of such county, the county signified in 15the school district number shall be the county in the district with the highest dollar value modifier. 16
