AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to permits issued by the department of conservation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 252.280, to read as follows:

**252.280. Any United States citizen, business, or corporation who
2 is not considered a resident of Missouri but owns at least eighty acres
3 of real property in Missouri shall only be assessed fifty percent of the
4 nonresident fee for any hunting, fishing, or trapping permit for use
5 only on the real property owned; provided however, that such
6 nonresident shall also provide a property tax receipt for the tax year
7 which immediately precedes the current calendar year in accordance
8 with the requirements set forth in section 301.025 for providing proof
9 of property tax receipts, or a statement certified by the county or
10 township collector for such previous year that no such taxes were
11 assessed or due and the nonresident has no unpaid taxes on the
12 collector's tax roll for any subsequent year, for such real property
13 owned in Missouri. If a business or corporation owns the requisite
14 amount of real property, only one person within the business or
15 corporation shall be eligible to use the nonresident fee reductions
16 specified under this section.**
