## AN ACT

To authorize the conveyance of certain state properties to the city of Independence.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows: Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered 2 to sell, transfer, grant, convey, remise, release and forever quitclaim to all interest of the state of Missouri in property located in Jackson County, Missouri, to the City of Independence. - 3. The attorney general shall approve the form of the instrument 58 of conveyance. 59

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
