AN ACT

To repeal section 302.188, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to veteran designations on driver's licenses and identification cards.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 302.188, RSMo, is repealed and one new section
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 302.188, to read as follows:

302.188. 1. A person may apply to the department of revenue to obtain
2 a veteran designation on a driver's license or identification card issued under this
3 chapter by providing:

4 (1) A United States Department of Defense discharge document, otherwise
5 known as a DD Form 214, that shows a discharge status of "honorable" or
6 "general under honorable conditions" that establishes the person's service in the
7 Armed Forces of the United States; or

8 (2) A United States Uniformed Services Identification Card, otherwise
9 known as a DD Form 2, that includes a discharge status of "retired" or "reserve
10 retired" establishing the person's service in the Armed Forces of the United
11 States; [and] or

12 (3) **A United States Department of Veterans Affairs photo**
13 **identification card; or**

14 (4) **A discharge document WD AGO 53, WD AGO 55, WD AGO 53-**
15 **55, NAVPERS 553, NAVMC 78 PD, NAVCG 553, or DD 215 form that**
16 **shows a discharge status of "honorable" or "general under honorable**
17 **conditions"; and**

18 (5) Payment of the fee for the driver's license or identification card

20 2. If the person is seeking a duplicate driver's license with the veteran
21 designation and his or her driver's license has not expired, the fee shall be as
22 provided under section 302.185.

23 3. The department of revenue may determine the appropriate placement
24 of the veteran designation on the driver's licenses and identification cards
25 authorized under this section and may promulgate the necessary rules for
26 administration of this section.

27 4. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010,
28 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective
29 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and
30 if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and
31 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to
32 review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
33 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and
34 any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2012, shall be invalid and void.
