Dear Missouri Rx Plan Member:

Due to a law passed in 2014, your Missouri Rx (MORx) program coverage expires in 2017. The last day you can receive help with prescription drug co-payment costs from the MORx Program will be <u>June 30, 2017</u>. Prescriptions filled after this date will not be covered by MORx.

The resources below may provide help with prescription drug costs:

MO HealthNet (Medicaid). To see if you qualify for MO HealthNet, call the Family Support Division at 1-855-373-4636.

<u>The Partnership for Prescription Assistance (PPA)</u>. The PPA helps the uninsured and underinsured to get prescription medications from existing patient assistance programs. Call PPA at 1-888-477-2669.

<u>Rx Outreach</u>. Rx Outreach is a non-profit mail order pharmacy that provides affordable medications for people in need. To find out if you qualify for the program, call 1-800-769-3880.

<u>Community Leaders Assisting the Insured of Missouri (CLAIM)</u>. To see if you qualify for a Medicare savings program, speak with a CLAIMs counselor at 1-800-390-3330.

<u>Area Agencies on Aging (AAA)</u>. Missouri has ten AAA that are ready to assist you. To see if you qualify for a Medicare savings program, call AAA at 1-800-677-1116.
