## HOUSE BILL NO. 1504

## AN ACT

To amend chapter 41, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to zoning around National Guard training centers.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:
1	Section A. Chapter 41, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2	one new section, to be known as section 41.657, to read as
3	follows:
4	41.657. 1. The county governing body or county planning
5	commission, if any, of any county of the second classification
6	with more than fifty-eight thousand but fewer than sixty-five
7	thousand inhabitants, and any county of the third classification
8	without a township form of government and with more than
9	twenty-three thousand but fewer than twenty-six thousand
10	inhabitants may adopt ordinances regulating incompatible land
11	uses and structures within all or any portion of the
12	unincorporated area extending up to three thousand feet outward
13	from the boundaries of any National Guard training center if the
14	county has participated in the completion of a joint land use
15	study associated with that training center.
16	2. As used in this section, "incompatible land uses and
17	structures" are determined by the county governing body or county
18	planning commission, if any, to be incompatible with noise,

1	vibration, and other training impacts identified in the joint
2	land use study or the most recent state operational noise
3	management plan. Regulations the county governing body or county
4	planning commission, if any, determines are necessary to
5	effectuate the purposes of this section and the recommendations
6	in the joint land use study or operational noise management plan
7	may include, but are not limited to, density, lot size, outdoor
8	lighting, land use, construction standards, and subdivision of
9	land.
10	3. The county governing body or county planning commission,
11	if any, may also provide for coordination with National Guard
12	officials and notification to current and future property owners
13	with respect to potential incompatible land uses, military
14	training impacts, and the existence of any regulation adopted
15	under this section.
