Amend _____ SCS/House Bill No. 1291 , Page 6 , Section 94.900 , Line 111 ,

2 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 "108.120. 1. The county commissions of the counties of
 4 this state are hereby authorized to issue bonds for and on behalf
 5 of their respective counties for the construction,
 6 reconstruction, improvement, maintenance and repair of any and
 7 all public roads, highways, bridges [and], culverts, streets,
 8 avenues, or alleys within such county, including the payment of
 9 any cost, judgment and expense for property, or rights in
 10 property, acquired by purchase or eminent domain, as may be
 11 provided by law, in such amount and such manner as may be
 12 provided by the general law authorizing the issuance of bonds by
 13 counties.

14 2. The proceeds of all bonds issued under the provisions of
 15 this section shall be paid into the county treasury where they
 16 shall be kept as a separate fund to be known as "The Road Bond
 17 Construction Fund" and such proceeds shall be used only for the
 18 purpose mentioned herein. [Such funds may be used in the
 19 construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance and repair
 20 of any street, avenue, road or alley in any incorporated city,
 21 town or village if such street, avenue, road or alley or any part
 22 thereof shall form a part of a continuous road, highway, bridge
 23 or culvert of said county leading into or through such city, town

1 or village.] The county may contract with any other political
2 subdivision to share the proceeds of such bonds to be used for
3 the purposes authorized.

4 137.555. In addition to other levies authorized by law, the
5 county commission in counties not adopting an alternative form of
6 government and the proper administrative body in counties
7 adopting an alternative form of government, in their discretion
8 may levy an additional tax, not exceeding thirty-five cents on
9 each one hundred dollars assessed valuation, all of such tax to
10 be collected and turned into the county treasury, where it shall
11 be known and designated as "The Special Road and Bridge Fund" to
12 be used for road and bridge purposes and for no other purpose
13 whatever; except that the term "road and bridge purposes" may
14 include certain storm water control projects off rights of way
15 that are directly related to the construction of roads and
16 bridges, in any county of the first classification without a
17 charter form of government with a population of at least ninety
18 thousand inhabitants but not more than one hundred thousand
19 inhabitants, in any county of the first classification without a
20 charter form of government with a population of at least two
21 hundred thousand inhabitants, in any county of the first
22 classification without a charter form of government and bordered
23 by one county of the first classification and one county of the
24 second classification or in any county of the first
25 classification with a charter form of government and containing
26 part of a city with a population of three hundred thousand or
27 more inhabitants; provided, however, that all that part or
28 portion of such tax which shall arise from and be collected and
29 paid upon any property lying and being within any special road

1 district shall be paid into the county treasury and four-fifths
2 of such part or portion of such tax so arising from and collected
3 and paid upon any property lying and being within any such
4 special road district shall be placed to the credit of such
5 special road district from which it arose and shall be paid out
6 to such special road district upon warrants of the county
7 commission, in favor of the commissioners or treasurer of the
8 district as the case may be; provided further, that the part of
9 such special road and bridge tax arising from and paid upon
10 property not situated in any special road district and the
11 one-fifth part retained in the county treasury may, in the
12 discretion of the county commission and pursuant to a written
13 contract, be shared with any other political subdivision to be
14 used [in] for road and bridge purposes within the county,
15 including but not limited to constructing, improving or repairing
16 [any street in any incorporated city or village in the county, if
17 such street shall form a part of a continuous highway of such
18 county leading through such city or village] streets, avenues, or
19 alleys of such political subdivision."; and

20 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
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
