4	"student counseling facility" means any entity that provides

8	and operates in accordance with state and federal law pertaining
9	to mental health professions as well as applicable professional
10	and ethical codes.
11	2. Prior to January 1, 2020, the coordinating board for
12	higher education shall promulgate rules setting forth reasonable
13	standards and regulations for student counseling facilities at
14	public institutions of higher education in this state relating to
15	average wait time to see a mental health professional for an
16	initial appointment, the average number of sessions available to
17	students, when appropriate, before an off-campus referral,
18	prevention services and any other factors the coordinating board
19	for higher education determines are contributing factors leading
20	to the prevalence of mental health problems within the academic

community. After establishing such standards and regulations,

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the coordinating board for higher education shall develop a process for measuring an institution's ability to adequately meet student mental health needs using assessment criteria developed in validated studies of well-being and student mental health in order to ensure that the effectiveness of the student counseling programs are objectively evaluated.

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- 3. Beginning in the 2020-2021 school year, and continuing on an annual basis thereafter, each public institution of higher education shall publish a report measuring compliance with the standards established in subsection 2 of this section. If an institution does not meet these standards, it shall include in the report a plan to meet these standards within three academic years. Additionally, the report shall include a measure of the institution's ability to adequately meet student mental health needs, using the process established in subsection 2 of this section. All reports required by this section shall be made available to the public.
- 4. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2018, shall be invalid and void."; and

Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
