10	conveyance of any project owned by a political subdivision shall
11	be subject to voter approval if required by law.
12	2. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:
13	(1) "Competitive bidding process", a request for proposal
14	for the financing, development, or operation of the project,
15	including any deadline for submission of such proposals, and
16	notice of the request, which shall be published once a week for
17	two consecutive weeks in:
18	(a) A newspaper of general circulation in the city where
19	the proposed project is located;
20	(b) At least one construction industry trade publication
21	that is nationally distributed; and
22	(c) Such other publications or manner as the governing body

1 of the political subdivision may determine; 2 (2) "Concession agreement", a license or lease between a 3 private partner and a political subdivision for the development, finance, operation, or maintenance of a project, as such term is 4 defined in section 227.600. 5 6 3. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 7 political subdivisions may enter into concession agreements, 8 provided that: 9 (1) The term of the concession agreement shall be for a 10 term not exceeding thirty years; 11 (2) The political subdivision shall retain oversight of 12 operations of any such project; 13 The political subdivision shall retain oversight of (3) 14 rate setting methodology; 15 The political subdivision shall have the right to (4) 16 terminate the agreement if the private partner does not comply 17 with the concession agreement; and 18 (5) The concession agreement is supported by a preliminary 19 engineering and financial feasibility study, including an 20 estimate of the costs of the project and the rate impact on 21 customers during the life of the agreement. 22 4. The commission shall not be required to oversee, or 23 issue an annual report under section 227.669 for, projects 24 approved by political subdivisions, provided that any political 25 subdivision entering into a concession agreement shall use a 26 public-private partnership framework that shall include a 27 competitive bidding process. 28 5. Except as provided in subsection 1 of this section, the 29 provisions of sections 71.530, 71.550, 78.190, 78.630, 81.190,
