AN ACT

To repeal section 57.450, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the office of sheriff of the city of St. Louis.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.450, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 57.450, to read as follows:

57.450. All general laws relating and applicable to the sheriffs of the
2 several counties of this state shall apply to the same officer in the City of St.
3 Louis, except that the sheriff of the City of St. Louis shall not enforce the general
4 criminal laws of the state of Missouri unless such enforcement shall be incidental
5 to the duties customarily performed by the sheriff of the City of St. Louis. **The**
6 **sworn deputies of the office of the sheriff of the City of St. Louis shall**
7 **be eligible for training and licensure by the peace officer standards and**
8 **training commission under chapter 590.** All acts and parts of acts providing
9 for any legal process to be directed to any sheriff of any county shall be so
10 construed as to mean the sheriff of the city of St. Louis as if such officer were
11 specifically named in such act.
