## AN ACT

To repeal section 59.170, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to recording fees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 59.170, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted

in lieu thereof, to be known as section 59.170, to read as follows: 59.170. The recorder of deeds for Jackson County, Missouri, shall open an office at Kansas City, in which may be recorded deeds, deeds of trust, mortgages and other instruments affecting real property situated in that county, and in

which may be filed or filed for record all financing statements and other

instruments or statements incidental thereto affecting personal property, fixtures,

or other collateral. Deeds, deeds of trust, mortgages, and other instruments

affecting real property, and financing statements and other instruments

incidental thereto affecting personal property, fixtures, or other collateral may

also be recorded or filed for record at the recorder's office located at the county

seat of any county with a charter form of government and with more than six

hundred thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants. In

addition to any other fee, the recorder of deeds in the county described

13 in this section shall be authorized to collect a user fee of two dollars on

each document or instrument described in this section that is recorded 14

in any office described in this section, which fee, when collected, shall

be deposited to the general revenue of that county.
