## AN ACT

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school administrators.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 168.305, to read as follows:

168.305. 1. In addition to the requirements set forth in 5 CSR 20-2 400.500, 5 CSR 20-400.610, 5 CSR 20-400.620, and 5 CSR 20-400.630 relating to administrator certification, an applicant for an initial administrator certificate, a transition administrator certificate, or a career continuous administrator certificate shall be required to complete a course in personnel management.

7 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall promulgate a rule delineating which personnel management courses shall satisfy the requirement of subsection 1 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010 that is 10 created under the authority delegated in this section shall become 11 12 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions 13 of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the 16 effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule 17proposed or adopted after August 28, 2018, shall be invalid and void. 18
