AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to victim impact programs for persons found guilty of driving while intoxicated.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 577.011, to read as follows:

577.011. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as 2 "Toby's Law".

- 2. In addition to other terms and conditions imposed on a person
- who has been found guilty of driving while intoxicated under section
- 5 577.010, such person shall complete a victim impact program approved
- 6 by the court. Attendance in such program shall be in person unless
- 7 there are extraordinary circumstances preventing in-person
- 8 attendance. Such person shall be responsible for any charges imposed
- 9 by the victim impact program.
