AN ACT

To repeal section 34.048, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to public contracts for purchasing supplies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 34.048, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 34.048, to read as follows:

34.048. In any contract for purchasing supplies [as defined in section
2 34.010 not exceeding the threshold for competitive bids set forth under section
3 34.040], the office of administration shall not prevent any department, office,
4 board, commission, bureau, institution, political subdivision, or any other agency
5 of the state from purchasing supplies from an authorized General Services
6 Administration vendor including "GSA Advantage", "GSA e-Buy", or successor
7 sources.
