15	(4) "Vegetation management plan", a written document that
16	includes short-term and long-term site management practices that
17	will provide and maintain native perennial vegetation.
18	3. The University of Missouri extension service, in
19	consultation with other state and nongovernmental agencies with
20	expertise in pollinators, shall publish a scorecard that sets
21	forth criteria for making a claim that a solar site is
22	pollinator-friendly or provides benefits to pollinators. The
23	scorecard shall be available on the website of the University of
24	Missouri extension service within six months of the effective

4. An owner of a solar site may follow practices at the
solar site that provide native perennial vegetation and foraging
habitat beneficial to pollinators.

5 5. An owner of a solar site implementing site management 6 practices under this section may claim that the site is 7 pollinator-friendly or provides benefits to pollinators only if 8 the site and the site's vegetation management plan adhere to the 9 criteria set forth in the University of Missouri extension 10 service's scorecard described under subsection 3 of this section. 11 6. An owner making a claim that a solar site is pollinator-12 friendly or provides benefits to pollinators shall make the solar 13 site's completed scorecard and vegetation management plan 14 available to the public and provide a copy to the University of 15 Missouri extension service and a nonprofit solar industry trade
