AN ACT

To repeal section 36.152, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the political activity of certain state employees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 36.152, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 36.152, to read as follows:

36.152. For the purposes of sections 36.152 to 36.159, the following terms mean:

- (1) "Contribution", as defined in chapter 130;
- (2) "Employee", any individual holding a position subject to the provisions of [this chapter in an executive agency of the state] **section 36.030 or section 36.031**;
- (3) "Partisan political office", any office for which any candidate is nominated or elected as representing a party pursuant to chapter 115.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
