AN ACT

To amend chapter 558, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to required minimum prison sentences.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 558, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 558.400, to read as follows:

558.400. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Justice Safety Valve Act".

- 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, when sentencing a defendant found guilty of an offense for which there is a statutory minimum sentence or a minimum prison term as required under section 558.019, but which did not:
 - (1) Include the use, attempted use, or threatened use of forcible compulsion by the defendant against another person or result in the serious physical injury of another person by the defendant;
- 10 (2) Involve any sexual conduct, as defined in section 566.010, by
 11 the defendant against a minor, other than an offense involving sexual
 12 conduct if the victim was at least fourteen years of age or older and the
 13 defendant was not more than four years older than the victim and the
 14 sexual conduct was consensual; or
- 15 (3) Include the brandishing or discharge of a firearm by the 16 defendant;
- 17 the court may depart from the applicable statutory minimum sentence
- 18 or minimum prison term if the court finds substantial and compelling
- 19 reasons on the record that, in giving due regard to the nature of the
- 20 offense, the history and character of the defendant, and his or her
- 21 changes of successful rehabilitation, imposition of the statutory
