JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to voter turnout thresholds for tax increases.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on
2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special
3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted
4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following
5 amendment to article X of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding
2 thereto one new section, to be known as section 27, to read as follows:

**Section 27. Any proposal by the state or a county, municipality,
2 or other political subdivision for a new tax or fee or an increase in an
3 existing tax or fee that is submitted to the voters for approval shall not
4 become effective unless such proposal receives a qualified majority in
5 favor of the proposal and at least fifty percent of qualified voters cast
6 a ballot in the election.**
