15	30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund
16	shall be administered by the commissioner of the department of
17	elementary and secondary education. The school transportation
18	fund shall consist of moneys transferred by the department
19	pursuant to subsection 1 of this section, to be used by public
20	school districts to provide transportation to students. Such

funds shall be paid to public school districts in addition to the

state aid provided for transportation pursuant to section

163.161, based on the cost of pupil transportation in accordance
with section 163.161.

- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.
- (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.
- 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply in any year in which state transportation aid reaches seventy-five percent of the total allowable cost of transporting all pupils eligible to be transported."; and
